## NOTES FOR CONTRIBUTORS

1. The Editor is pleased to receive suitable articles for "Tropical Grasslands" on the understanding that they are original and not offered to any other journal for publication. Suitable articles include results of applied research, species testing, pasture establishment, development, maintenance and evaluation, animal performance studies and soil fertility studies, critical field observation, documented case studies of successful primary enterprises, letters to the Editor, reviews and other material the Editor considers suitable.

Contributors are not required to be members of the society. Contributions of a suitable nature from countries other than Australia will be welcomed, provided they are of international interest and not locally specific—as for example with studies of fertilizer requirements for a particular soil type or grazing trials applicable only to a single province, state or country.

2. Articles should be concise and not exceeding 5000 words. Longer articles may be accepted, but then a charge based on cost of printing may be made. All costs involved in preparation of blocks and etchings for figures will be charged.

3. The following points of style should be noted:

THE FRONT PAGE of the paper should give only the title, names of author(s) and address(es), including the present address(es) of authors who have moved, and an abbreviated title.

HEADINGS: Main headings are in upper case (capital) letters and not underlined. All subheadings are in lower case italics (or underlined) with only the first letter in capitals. Main subheadings are centred and sub subheadings (if required) on the left margin.

REFERENCES are to be written out in full without abbreviations, following the style, layout and punctuation as used in this issue.

TABLES AND FIGURES should be set out separately at the end of the paper, their point of insertion marked in the text by "*Insert Figure/Table x here*". Tables should have the overall format of tables in this issue. Figures will normally be reduced to column width (12.5 cm). Captions for figures, which should be brief but explanatory, are to be listed on a separate sheet at the end of the paper. Figures and plates should be submitted approximately twice the size of final reproduction. Figures should be drawn boldly and neatly in Indian ink or equivalent on good quality materials. If numbers and letters are placed on originals of figures they must be entered equally neatly and not, for example, by typewriter. Alternatively, figures may be drawn without numbering or lettering, which can then be placed on a photocopy of the original. This lettering will then be typeset into the original during printing.

UNITS OF MEASUREMENT must be metric.

MANUSCRIPTS should be typed on one side of the page and double spaced; two copies to be submitted to the Editor. All manuscripts must be written in the English language.

4. The minimum reprint order is 100 copies, at a cost of A\$10.00 per journal page. Orders in excess of 100 will be charged at A\$6.00 per page per 50 copies.

Reprints should be ordered when the paper is submitted for publication, and a purchase order or requisition number enclosed when galley proofs are returned.
